On **Wednesday, December 14, 2016**, Educational Testing Service will present the 2016–17 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) Pretest Workshop Webcast to prepare local educational agencies (LEAs) to administer the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and the California Alternate Assessments (CAAs).

The Pretest Workshop Webcast consists of two parts:

- Part I: Administration of the online Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and California Science Test pilot test, beginning at 9 a.m. Pacific time (PT)
- Part II: Administration of the CAAs, including the CAA for Science pilot test, beginning at 1 p.m. PT

Each part is scheduled for two hours but may run longer to answer viewer questions. Viewers will learn about a number of critical topics, including the following:

- Test Administration
- Interim Assessments and the Digital Library
- Technology Infrastructure
- Test Operations Management System
- Test Security
- Available Reports
