Dear LEA CAASPP Coordinator:

An issue with **Android 5+ devices** using version 2.0 of the Android Mobile Secure Browser (MSB) has been identified. The issue is that the keyboard fails to operate on certain devices. In response to this information, a new secure browser, **MSB 2.1**, has been deployed and is available to download in the Google Play store. **Any local educational agency (LEA) using Android 5+ devices for testing should upgrade to MSB 2.1** in order to have the keyboard function correctly. LEAs using Android 4 devices do not need to upgrade in order to continue testing.
