Version assignments for the administration for the California Alternate Assessments (CAAs) are now available on the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) CAA Version Assignments Web page at <http://www.caaspp.org/administration/about/caa/caa-assignments.2016-17.html>. Version assignment PDF links are sorted by county. Version assignments in the PDFs are listed by local educational agency (LEA) and then school.

Secure *CAA Directions for Administration (DFAs) for English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA) and Mathematics* that correspond to these version assignments **will be available for download from the Test Operations Management System (TOMS) on Monday, March 20, 2017**. When you open TOMS, select the **[? Help]** button in the top-right corner of all pages on the Web site and then select the **[CAA Secure Materials]** tab to see a list of available documents. There will be five versions per grade level; schools should select and download the *DFA(s)* that match their assigned version numbers and distribute to CAA test examiners who have signed and returned CAASPP Test Security Affidavits (available at <http://www.caaspp.org/administration/forms/>) and have completed CAA test examiner training.
