You are receiving this e-mail because you have students who have been assigned the Stacked Spanish Translations embedded designated support for the California Science Test (CAST), which will be available starting on April 2, 2018. Please note that, for the CAST, there are some differences in the way certain questions, such as inline choice questions, will be displayed when using this resource.

An inline choice question contains one or more blanks that the student must fill in by selecting an answer from a drop-down list of choices. For the CAST only, some of the drop-down lists for performance task items are not in Spanish (although their translations are available), so students will have to select a response from the English version of the drop-down list. The majority of drop-down list items will be in Spanish. See page 26 in [chapter 1 of the Accessibility Guide for CAASPP Online Testing](#) for additional information on this topic.

Additionally, some other types of questions will have answer options available in Spanish only.

Please ensure that students designated for this accessibility resource are literate in Spanish before assigning this resource.
