Dear LEA CAASPP Coordinator:

The online California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) test administration window can only be extended by a local educational agency (LEA) CAASPP coordinator if the LEA's selected testing window meets **all** of the following three criteria:

- 1. The extension will not cause the end date of the new selected testing window to occur after the end date of the regulatory testing window.
- 2. The extension request is made prior to the last date of the selected testing window.
- 3. The selected testing window has **not** expired.

LEA CAASPP coordinators can request a test window extension of up to 10 consecutive instructional days (*California Code of Regulations*, Title 5, Section 855 [b] [4]) by contacting the **California Technical Assistance Center (CalTAC).** Each request will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
