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Dear LEA CAASPP Coordinator:

The secure browser used by iPads for California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) online testing has been updated in the Apple Store. Local educational agencies whose students had previously experienced issues with the text-to-speech accommodation testing using iOS 8 or 9 on an iPad are encouraged to upgrade their secure browser application for the most optimal experience.

The AIRSecureTest mobile secure browser for iPads can be downloaded from the App store. The process for installing the secure browser is the same as for any other application.

1. On your iPad, tap or select the **[Download]** button. The AIRSecureTest application download Web page will open.
2. Tap or select the **[Free]** button. The button will change to **[Install App]**.
3. Tap or select **[Install App]**.
4. Enter your Apple ID password.
5. The AIRSecureTest mobile secure browser app will download and install onto the iPad.
