Dear LEA CAASPP Coordinator:

The 2017–18 downloadable student score data extract file for your local educational agency's (LEA's) CAASPP testing is now available in the [Reports] section of the Test Operations Management System (TOMS).

Your LEA's student data file includes all students enrolled in your LEA who were in the California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS) and whose tests were scored at the time data was extracted on June 15, 2018. However, the data file does not contain student scores for the California Alternate Assessment (CAA), nor does it contain field test preliminary indicator data for the California Science Test (CAST).

The student data file includes the following:

- Scores for the Smarter Balanced Summative online assessments for English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics given in grades three through eight and grade eleven
- Scores for the Standards-based Tests in Spanish (STS) for Reading/Language Arts in grades two through eleven

The demographic data for your enrolled students is based on the following:

- If your LEA's selected testing window closed before June 15, 2018, the demographic data in your LEA student data file is from your LEA's demographic snapshot. The demographic snapshot was taken after the selected testing window closed for your LEA's CAASPP administration and cannot be corrected.
- If your LEA's selected testing window was still open as of June 15, 2018, the student demographic data in your LEA student data file reflects the latest demographic data that was available in CALPADS at the time the data was extracted on June 15, 2018. The demographic snapshot for your LEA was taken after the selected testing window closed for your LEA's CAASPP administration.

Note: The data file contains students who were enrolled in the LEA at the close of the LEA's selected testing window. The resulting numbers may not exactly match aggregate data posted on the public web reporting site in September because the aggregation is based on students' enrolled school at the time when the test was taken.

Accessing the Individual Student Test Results Data File

The [layout of the student data file](#) is also available for download from the CAASPP [Score Reporting](#) web page. The student data file layout includes field descriptions, acceptable values for fields, and data sources.

Take these steps to securely download your LEA's student data files:

1. Access [TOMS](#).
2. Select the [**Reports**] button in the left navigation bar.
3. Scroll down to the *Student Results Report—Student Score Data Extract* section.
4. Select your Organization and the School Year of the data file you would like to download. (Data files are available for the current and two previous CAASPP administrations.)
5. Select the [**DOWNLOAD REPORT**] button.

Educational Testing Service will provide updated student data files at the beginning of September 2018 that include student score data for the CAAs for ELA and mathematics and any remaining Smarter Balanced and STS results that were not processed when the first file was generated. Final files that contain the field test preliminary indicator data for the CAST will be available in late fall 2018.
