**Subject:** New Web-based ISAAP Tool Is Now Available



Dear LEA CAASPP or LEA ELPAC Coordinator:

The California Department of Education and Educational Testing Service would like to introduce the new web-based Individual Student Assessment Accessibility Profile (ISAAP) Tool. The ISAAP Tool can be used by educators to identify accessibility resources for students taking any of the 2020–21 CAASPP or ELPAC assessments.

CAASPP and ELPAC users will be able import student demographic data into the ISAAP Tool's web-based system or enter data manually. Once student data is entered, users can select specific assessments and identify student needs. Based on the assessments and student needs, the ISAAP Tool will create a list of available accessibility resources that can be selected for the student. After selecting accessibility resources, the ISAAP Tool can be used to export a file that can be loaded directly into the Test Operations Management System to establish student test settings. The uploaded file can contain data for up to 500 students at a time (unlike the macro-enabled, spreadsheet-based ISAAP Tool, which had a limit of 15 students).

The web-based ISAAP Tool is one step in the process of ensuring that each student receives the accessibility resources necessary to provide for fair and valid testing.
