1. Representations

2. Acknowledgment and Assignment
  - a. The Contestant acknowledges that its Submission will become the sole and exclusive product of the CDE, from the date written by the Contestant on this Form, and that the Submission will remain the product of the CDE in perpetuity.
  - b. The Contestant assigns all rights, title and interest and in and to the Submission to the CDE; waives any moral rights it may have to the submission; and agrees to sign any such additional documents necessary to transfer and protect the CDE's rights to and interest in the Submission.
  - c. The Contestant acknowledges that the Submission may be edited, altered, and/or used in any manner whatsoever, in any medium, for any time, as deemed necessary by the CDE.
3. Indemnity
  - a.
