The [2019–20 California Alternate Assessment \(CAA\) Test Examiner Tutorials](#) are now available to support administration of the California Alternate Assessments (CAAs) for English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics. These required sets of tutorials are composed of modules covering the CAA general administration and content areas.

Test examiners may select from one of three tutorials:

1. CAA general administration and CAAs for ELA and mathematics—
Completion time: approximately 40 minutes
2. CAA general administration and CAA for Science—Completion time:
approximately 50 minutes
3. CAA general administration and CAAs for ELA, mathematics, **and** science—
Completion time: approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes

What follows are some of the topics that will be covered in the tutorials:

- Test examiner roles and responsibilities
- Test security protocols
- Assigning accessibility resources
- How testing works
- How to determine version assignments
- Directions for Administration
- Resources

After viewing the tutorials, test examiners can download and print a certificate of completion. The certificate of completion is required for all test examiners to administer the CAAs.
